**APRIL 14, 2010 - BROOKINGS, SD** - Construction on the Brookings High School Expansion is scheduled to begin with a ground breaking ceremony on Wednesday, April 21 at 4:00 p.m. The Brookings Board of Administration and faculty are excited for this project to begin and hope that you can attend the ceremony.

The expansion includes a new commons/cafeteria and kitchen/servery organized on a radial pattern with large windows saturating the space with natural light. Also included are three new classrooms and a student study area on the northeast corner of the school.

The auditorium, administration and guidance areas are upgraded. The existing cafeteria will become a shop and green room to serve the auditorium. A new entry is established for the existing library along the main corridor of the High School. This main corridor embraces a main street theme, allowing each of the adjacent spaces to have its own identity and to be easily identifiable along the "street".

The work is scheduled to be completed in August 2011.
