SIoux FALLS, SD, NOVEMBER 8, 2005 - Award winning South Dakota architecture was recognized at the recent American Institute of Architects (AIA) South Dakota convention. Honor awards were presented for the design of the YWCA and Falls Overlook Café, while the Sullivan Health Science Center earned a Merit award. All three award-winning projects were designed by Koch Hazard Architects of Sioux Falls.

AIA South Dakota design awards recognize outstanding building projects recently completed within the state. The awards banquet was held on October 7, concluding the AIA South Dakota annual convention. There were 14 projects submitted this year.
