SIoux FALLS, SD July 19, 2005 - The addition to Colorado Technical University is nearly complete. The project was designed by Koch Hazard Architects for Henry Carlson Company.

The addition encompasses 17,400 square feet and includes 12 new classrooms, a lecture space that can be subdivided into three large seminar rooms, laboratory space, offices, restrooms and a new loading dock. The addition will provide new features, such as space for students to meet with professors, extra space for admission, a classroom to hold community meetings and a new IT help desk for faculty and students.

The current building has been in use only since 1998, but the addition was needed to accommodate the growing enrollment and new programs.

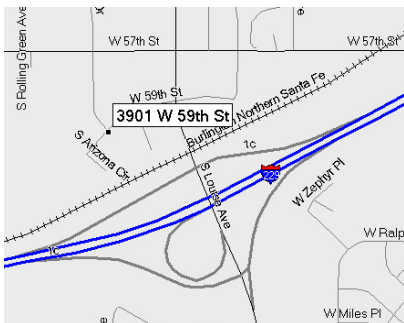
"Last fall we had over 1,200 students and only 20,000 square feet," said Vicki Strunk, Colorado Technical University president. "We definitely needed extra space."

The addition was designed to complement the original Colorado Technical University facilities. "The current building has an extremely efficient design and beautiful detail. ... The design [of the addition] looks similar to what we have and seems to match well. It's looking really good," said Strunk.

The addition is scheduled to be complete this September.
