ABERDEEN, SD, AUGUST 16, 2005 - Construction will officially be underway on Thursday, August 18th for a new Technology Center at Northern State University. The groundbreaking ceremony will be held at 9:30 a.m. at the MeWaldt-Jensen building on the NSU campus.

The project encompasses 39,000 square feet on four levels and includes a technology help desk, technology support, testing center, computer classrooms, two multimedia studios, office space for technology and arts and sciences faculty and staff. The Technology Center will provide the campus with a new image and will be prominently located at the terminus of the formal quadrangle. Gray Construction of Watertown, SD is the general contractor.

This state of the art facility represents NSU's growing role as a leader in technology and distance learning. "Through the NSU Technology Center and the Statewide E-Learning program, NSU will continue to reach school districts and students from smaller communities across the state that would otherwise not be able to offer advanced classes to those in need," said Northern State University President Patrick Shloss.

The addition is scheduled to be completed in August 2006.
